- 1. A description of the problem
- 2. When/how it occurred (so we can try to reproduce it!)
- 3. A screenshot
- 4. Your operating system (e.g. Windows 10) and browser (e.g. Mozilla Firefox)

We'll investigate and get back to you :) For a suggestion, please include a brief description of your idea and a little information about why it would be useful to you!
